WEATHER CONDITIONS FOR VINTAGE

The Russian River Valley had a mixed and somewhat challenging growing season in 2022. Winter was relatively dry with limited rainfall. February was unseasonably sunny and warm, prompting for early budbreak leaving vines susceptible to early season frost. By August and September, record heat arrived, accelerating ripening and harvest. The Pinot Noir yields were a little depressed in the Russian River Valley, but we are seeing great concentration and flavor in the wines as a result.

Our Fog Veil Pinot Noir harvest began on August 26th.

VINIFICATION COMMENTS

Sourced from three distinctive vineyard sites in the Santa Rosa plains neighborhood of the Russian River Valley. Our Fog Veil vineyards are planted on alluvial plains along the eastern reaches of the valley. Here fog tends to burn off earlier, resulting in long warm days throughout the growing season.

WINEMAKER COMMENTS

NOSE: Blackberry, black cherry, and molasses.

PALATE: Plum, boysenberry, and hints of tea show layers of flavor and vibrant acidity. Firm yet integrated tannins offer a generous mouthfeel and drive a long and balanced finish.
